RANDY (CONT'D)

ON THE TV: JOHN MADDEN AND AL MICHAELS IN A PROMO

JOHN MADDEN

Join us for the Super Bowl next weekend, football fans. And don't worry - the world's all-time favorite quarterback will be there too.

RANDY

What? Please no.

AL MICHAELS

That's right, John. Peyton Manning may be out of the big dance but we have him live in studio, on the sidelines and in both locker rooms before, during and after the entire game.

RANDY

Dear God.

JOHN MADDEN

And don't forget Fox's patented Peyton Cam - sure to bring you all the Peyton Manning action all the time.

RANDY

Make it stop.

AL MICHAELS

And it doesn't stop!

JOHN MADDEN

Manning is also singing along with Bruce Springsteen and his E-Street Band during the half-time show. Rocking!

Randy turns furious.

STAN

Dad, are you okay?

RANDY

Goddamn you, Peyton Manning. Get your laser rocket arm off my television!

Randy stands and puts his foot through the TV.

Sharon rushes in.

SHARON

What are you doing, Randy?

Randy turns his hatred toward Sharon.

RANDY

None of your business! Sundays are my alone days. My. Alone. Days.

SHARON

Why are you being such an asshole?

RANDY

Dammit. Sometimes I want to strangle you. I want to choke you until you die.

SHARON

I should've killed you in Mexico.

Stan stares at them. A long pause.

RANDY

Son, go to your room.

EXT. BUS STOP - MORNING

KYLE, STAN, and CARTMAN wait for the bus.

KYLE

Did you guys watch that playoff game?

CARTMAN

Dude, someday I'm totally going to play in the NFL. It's going to be awesome.

STAN

Cartman, you can't play in the NFL. Your ass drags on the ground when you walk.

CARTMAN

Whatever. I'm allowed a certain amount of baby fat now. But in high school I expect a series of growth spurts. I'll take that ball to the house.

KYLE

Anyway. Did you guys watch that game?

CARTMAN

I was watching this super-creepy scary show about the Duggar family. It was some sick shit, man.

STAN

The Duggar family?

CARTMAN

Yeah. They're these crazy Jesus people who don't believe in birth control and keep reproducing kids like a factory. They have 18 children - each one playing a stringed musical instrument.

Kyle hits Cartman with a snowball.

KYLE

That's not a scary movie, dumbass. It's a reality TV show about a family from Arkansas.

CARTMAN

No freaking way, man. This sick bastard was building an army. He gave each of them different skills to use after the Armageddon rains down upon us.

Kyle hits Cartman with another snowball.

CARTMAN (CONT'D)

Stop throwing snowballs at me Goddammit!

INT. BUS - LATER

KYLE, STAN and CARTMAN ride in the back.

STAN

Dudes, my dad was freaking out last night. He put his foot through the TV.

CARTMAN

Has he tried pills? My mom swallows a handful whenever her face turns red.

STAN

He got mad while we were watching football. I think it was because of that douche bag Peyton Manning.

KYLE

Dude? Peyton Manning isn't a douche bag. He is the best clutch player in the NFL.

CARTMAN

He is so douchey. He looks like a quarterback from the 1940s or some junk.

KYLE

If he's a douche bag then why did he win the Super Bowl and host Saturday Night Live? Why is he on so many commercials?

CARTMAN

Those are things only a douche bag would do. Peyton Manning is the douchiest.

INT. CLASSROOM - DAY

KYLE, STAN and CARTMAN in class.

KYLE

Stan, you can't blame Peyton Manning for your parents' constant arguing.

STAN

Peyton Manning has to be the reason. Ever since my dad saw his first Peyton Manning commercial things have been going downhill at home.

INT. STAN'S HOUSE - FLASHBACKS

Football Sunday. RANDY and KYLE on the couch. SHARON washes dishes in the kitchen.

PEYTON MANNING IN A TV COMMERCIAL.

PEYTON MANNING

Hello, everyone. I'm Peyton Manning of the National Football League. Whenever I get home from playing a rough and tumble game on the field, I wash my gear with Tide Ultra Detergent. Hits Stains Hard.

RANDY

Peyton Manning doesn't do his own laundry. Hardworking everyday people do. That son of a bitch is liar.

Sharon rushes in.

SHARON

Don't use that language around our son!

RANDY

Shut up, you dirty whore!

SHARON

Your mustache looks ridiculous.

RANDY

So does your pubic hair!

ANOTHER SUNDAY

PEYTON MANNING

Have a headache? Don't go to your doctor. Go to your drugstore. Tylenol Ultra Formula. Hits Headaches Hard.

RANDY

Peyton Manning doesn't go to the drugstore. He has prescription-strength medicine prescribed by team physicians. That stupid lying ignorant bastard.

Sharon rushes in.

SHARON

What did I say about the language?

RANDY

He could hear worse if he listened to you sleep at night, trollop!

ANOTHER SUNDAY

KYLE and CARTMAN listen to STAN'S story.

CARTMAN
Dude. It sounds like Peyton Manning IS
the source of your family's problems.

STAN
I know. And this weekend my dad is going
to watch the Super Bowl and Peyton
Manning is going to be all over it.

KYLE
I know. They have that super-awesome
Peyton Cam --

Kyle stops himself.

KYLE (CONT'D)
Sorry, dude.

CARTMAN
You said your dad put his foot through
the television, Stan. So without the TV
you have nothing to worry about.

STAN
Maybe you're right, Cartman. For once.

INT. STAN'S HOUSE - NIGHT

RANDY and STAN look at a new GIANT TV.

STAN

Are you sure we can afford this, Dad?

RANDY

It's called 'Rent to Own,' son. After 448 payments of \$29.95 this bad boy is ours.

SHARON enters. She and Randy are loving and flirtatious.

SHARON

Hello, dear. Is this the new television?

RANDY

It is, baby. Now you won't have to squint while we watch QVC.

SHARON

Oh my. I love it.

RANDY

And I love you.

Sharon smiles.

SHARON

I have to make dinner. I'll see you in a few, handsome.

RANDY

You better get out of here before I smack that fanny and teach you a lesson.

Sharon giggles and leaves.

RANDY (CONT'D)

All right, son. Let's do this.

Randy grabs the remote and turns on the TV.

ON THE SCREEN: PEYTON MANNING SITS ON A TOILET

RANDY (CONT'D)

No. Please. No.

PEYTON MANNING

That's why I use Preparation H Ultra Formula. Hits hemorrhoids hard.

RANDY
That no-good fucking Peyton Manning!

Sharon rushes in.

SHARON
What did you say?

RANDY
Stay out of this! It has nothing to do with you! It's about that douche bag Peyton Manning!

SHARON

INT. SCHOOL - DAY

KYLE and STAN in class. MR. GARRISON sits at a desk.

STAN
Dude, my Dad bought a bigger TV yesterday and he got even madder when he saw Peyton Manning on it. If I don't stop Peyton Manning from ruining the Super Bowl, my dad might burn down the house or kill us all or something.

KYLE
That sucks, man.

STAN
I know. What am I supposed to do?

CARTMAN is silhouetted in a far corner of the room, smoking a cigarette. Cartman Noir.

CARTMAN
Isn't it obvious, Stan?

STAN
Isn't what obvious?

CARTMAN
We have to take out Peyton Manning.

KYLE
What do you mean "take out?"

CARTMAN
Not to lunch, Kyle, if that's what you were thinking. We have to do whatever we can to stop that douche bag from gaining one frame of screen time this Sunday.

KYLE
That's impossible. Even if we could physically restrain Peyton Manning, who is a professional athlete, we can't stop the commercials from airing.

Cartman approaches them, dutiful.

CARTMAN
Leave the commercials to me, boys. We're going to save poor Stan's family.

Mr. Garrison smells something.

MR. GARRISON
Is someone smoking a Turkish Blend?

Cartman tosses the cigarette. It hits BUTTERS in the face.

BUTTERS
Oh no! My face!

Mr. Garrison walks over and stomps the cigarette out.

MR. GARRISON
Come with me, Mr. Joe Camel.

Mr. Garrison leads Butters by the arm. The students laugh.

BUTTERS
It burns, sir! It burns so badly!

ACT II

EXT. PLAYGROUND - DAY

KYLE, STAN and CARTMAN at recess.

CARTMAN

Dudes. Those Duggar bastards were on TV again last night. They say they're birthing these babies for Jesus. And now some of their babies are having babies. They're multiplying exponentially.

STAN

I don't care about the Duggars, Cartman. You said you had a plan to keep Peyton Manning off of the Super Bowl broadcast.

CARTMAN

Not just the Super Bowl, Stan.

Cartman presents a ROUGH SCHEMATIC from his pocket: EARTH, a SATELLITE and PEYTON MANNING. The three boys huddle around.

CARTMAN (CONT'D)

After the alien probe and subsequent satellite dish were shoved up my ass I started studying broadcast media.

KYLE

This drawing sucks, Cartman.

STAN

Let him talk, dude.

CARTMAN

If we can somehow manage to keep Peyton Manning off television for just a few hours, we may take away enough of his celebrity power to weaken him forever.

KYLE

Weaken him forever?

CARTMAN

Yes, Kyle. For the last eight years Peyton Manning has had a controlling share of television programming and advertising in the United States. In '07 he overcame Regis Philbin for the most saturated celebrity in the country. Since then it's been a non-stop onslaught of everything Manning.

STAN

So if we keep Peyton Manning off TV for a few hours people will forget about him?

CARTMAN

We'll never be able to forget about him, Stan. He's been in far too many clever commercials for that. But we might lessen his stranglehold on the American people.

KYLE

The Super Bowl is in Tampa Bay. How do you plan on getting there, dipshit?

CARTMAN

It's all being taken care of. But before we devise a course of action we must first know what is at stake, Kyle.

KYLE

This is stupid. I'm going to find a PSP and salvage this recess.

Kyle leaves. Cartman and Stan are left.

CARTMAN

Looks like it's just me and you, Stan. Let's just hope your father can hold out until the day of the Super Bowl.

EXT. DOWNTOWN - NIGHT

The street is empty. RANDY and STAN walk past boutique shops.

RANDY

I'm sorry things have been rough around the house lately, son. I don't know what has come over me.

STAN

Are you and Mom getting divorced?

RANDY

I don't think so. We've just hit a rough patch. Every family goes through them.

They stop at an ELECTRONICS STORE. Stan sees several TELEVISIONS in the front window. Disaster looms.

STAN

Let's keep walking, Dad. There's an ice cream shop up the street.

RANDY

Look at these prices. I should've bought a smaller television. That douche bag Peyton Manning just got me so riled up.

STAN

Seriously, Dad. Let's go.

ON THE TELEVISIONS: A COMMERCIAL BREAK

Stan pulls on Randy's arm.

RANDY

Hold on, son. What's the rush?

ON THE TELEVISIONS: PEYTON MANNING

PEYTON MANNING

Hey, do you like green olives?

Randy's blood boils.

RANDY

ARRRGH!!!

Randy grabs a nearby mailbox and throws it through the window. IT SHATTERS. He puts his foot through each individual television and then slams them all against the ground.

Stan watches in horror.

STAN

Dad! Please stop!

SIRENS in the distance.

RANDY

C'mon, son. We're out of here.

A police car screeches to a halt in front of the store. OFFICER BARBRADY exits.

OFFICER BARBRADY

Goddamn kids!

EXT. PLAYGROUND - DAY

KYLE, STAN and CARTMAN at recess.

KYLE

So did you guys hear about those hooligans who smashed up the electronics store last night?

CARTMAN

No way. I was watching the Duggars again. They were starring in a community play, but the entire cast was made up of Duggars. It was so creepy.

STAN

No. I didn't hear about it.

KYLE

Apparently some kids put their feet through every TV screen in the store.

Cartman and Kyle look to Stan.

STAN

Okay. It was my Dad. He saw Peyton Manning on all those screens and flipped out. All those smaller TVs made him even madder than the one big TV.

KYLE

Your dad is a fucking psycho.

STAN

No he's not, man. It's this douche bag Peyton Manning. Do you have a plan yet, Cartman?

CARTMAN

I'm devising one, Stan. And last night I made a major breakthrough. Let me introduce you to a little liquid called Chloroform.

Cartman shows them a BOTTLE.

STAN

Isn't that what makes plants green?

CARTMAN

No. Chloroform is a chemical that suppresses enemies swiftly. Only the deadliest assassins and secret agents use it, but I found a recipe on the Internet.

INT. CARTMAN'S HOUSE - FLASHBACK

CARTMAN with a small LAB SET in the living room.

He examines three layers of liquid in a large cylinder while referencing a printout.

CARTMAN

So now that the compound has reacted, I just drain out the remainder and --

LIANE enters.

LIANE

Eric, is this a science experiment?

Cartman panics.

CARTMAN

Um... No, Mom.

LIANE

What is it then, dear?

CARTMAN

Um... I'm cooking something for you.

LIANE

Oh, that's so sweet. But it doesn't smell like anything.

Liane bends down to sniff the cylinder. She faints.

Cartman runs O.S. and returns with a fifth of booze, which he places in Liane's hand. He fills his bottle with Chloroform, throws the lab set in a closet and side-steps out the door.

INT. PLAYGROUND - CONTINUOUS

KYLE and STAN listen to CARTMAN'S story.

STAN

Did you kill your mom?

CARTMAN

No, Stan. Chloroform just makes its victims pass out for a while. It's completely harmless.

KYLE

So you're going to use this Chloroform on Peyton Manning?

CARTMAN

Yes. It's simple. We'll simply sneak up behind him...

Cartman dabs a CLOTH into the Chloroform. He waits - then smothers a nearby STUDENT. The Student faints.

CARTMAN (CONT'D)
Sleep, child. Sleep.

Stan and Kyle in shock.

STAN
Jesus Christ, Cartman!

KYLE
How long is he going to be out for?

CARTMAN
I'm not sure really. Don't act suspicious. Just slowly walk away.

Kyle, Stan and Cartman sidestep O.S.

INT. CLASSROOM - DAY

KYLE, STAN and CARTMAN sit in class.

BUTTERS eavesdrops. His face is bandaged.

KYLE
Even with your stupid Chloroform,
Cartman, how are you planning to get your
hands on Peyton Manning? Once again - the
Super Bowl is in Tampa Bay this year.

CARTMAN
We'll meet at my house tonight. Until
then, the less you know - the better.

BUTTERS
Hey, what are you fellas talking about?

CARTMAN
Nothing, Butters. Shut the hell up.

BUTTERS
I'm sorry if I offended you. I was only
trying to lend a hand. Did you say
something about Peyton Manning?

CARTMAN
Shut the hell up, Butters! We don't need
some pussy ruining our plans.

BUTTERS
But I was only trying to --

Cartman pulls out the cloth and smothers Butter. Butters faints. Stan and Kyle are shocked.

STAN
Holy shit, Cartman!

KYLE
You can't just go around Chloroforming people. This is crazy.

CARTMAN
Be cool. Just slowly slide away.

Kyle, Stan and Cartman scoot their desks O.S.

EXT. PLAYGROUND - LATER

CARTMAN looks suspicious. He WHISTLES while casually strolling underneath the jungle gym.

A FEW STUDENTS hang from the metal bars.

CARTMAN
Don't mind me. Just stretching my legs.

Cartman stops and leans against a pole.

CARTMAN (CONT'D)
Nothing to see here.

CARTMAN pounces again - Chloroforming the kids. One-by-one they drop from the bars.

CARTMAN (CONT'D)
This shit is awesome.

INT. CLASSROOM - CONTINUOUS

BUTTERS awakes alone in the room.

BUTTERS
Err... What happened? Where is everyone?

He becomes increasingly irritated.

BUTTERS (CONT'D)
Did someone play a trick on me? Why are they so mean? Is it something I've done? No. I'm kind and nice. But no more. No more Mr. Nice guy. This means war!

We watch HIS SHADOW on a wall. Butters TRANSFORMS into PROFESSOR CHAOS.

PROFESSOR CHAOS
Behold Professor Chaos!

INT. CARTMAN'S HOUSE - NIGHT

KYLE and STAN watch CARTMAN at a computer.

CARTMAN

Besides finding recipes for potentially lethal chemicals, the Internet is also a great way to grab cheap airfares.

Cartman pulls out a credit card.

STAN

Where did you get that credit card?

CARTMAN

It's my mother's. Let's see... three round-trip tickets for Tampa Bay. We'll arrive Saturday night...

LIANE's voice echoes from another room.

LIANE (O.S.)

Eric, honey. Have you seen my credit card anywhere?

CARTMAN

No, mom! I have friends over. Please leave me alone!

LIANE (O.S.)

Eric? Do your friends want any juice?

CARTMAN

No, mom! Shut up!

LIANE (O.S.)

Eric --

Cartman stands and rushes O.S. We here a THUD. He returns, screwing the cap on his bottle and not missing a beat.

CARTMAN

Three tickets to Tampa Bay. We name our price... BOOM. Peyton Manning is toast.

EXT. CARTMAN'S HOUSE - CONTINUOUS

PROFESSOR CHAOS watches through a window.

PROFESSOR CHAOS

Trying to stop Peyton Manning from appearing on the Super Bowl broadcast, huh? We'll see about that.

INT. CARTMAN'S HOUSE - CONTINUOUS

KYLE, STAN and CARTMAN at the computer.

KYLE

They'll never let us on a plane, Cartman.
You're just as crazy as Stan's dad.

CARTMAN

Please, Kyle. Just trust me.

A KNOCK AT THE DOOR.

STAN

What the hell was that?

CARTMAN

Perhaps one of my mother's gentleman
callers. Stay cool.

Cartman slowly opens the door... But no one is there. Kyle
and Stan approach the doorway.

CARTMAN (CONT'D)

Hello?

KYLE

Who knocked at the door?

CARTMAN

I'm not sure. But whoever it was, it
looks like they've switched our welcome
mat around.

The boys look at the MAT. It faces the doorway.

KYLE

Who would do something like that?

CARTMAN

Some sick motherfucker. That's who.

They stare at it longer.

STAN

It's actually kind of cool. Like, instead
of you welcoming other people to your
house - it welcomes you to the outside
world. It's a good way to start the day.

CARTMAN

You're right. Well, boys, I have to clean
up. Remember your instructions.

EXT. CARTMAN'S HOUSE - CONTINUOUS

CARTMAN closes the door. KYLE and STAN walk down the street.

PROFESSOR CHAOS appears from behind a bush.

PROFESSOR CHAOS

So you like the reversal of the welcome mat? Well this isn't over yet. Prepare to feel the wrath of Professor Chaos!

INT. CARTMAN'S HOUSE - CONTINUOUS

CARTMAN returns to the computer.

CARTMAN

Let's see what else is online.

MOANS from the computer. A porn site.

CARTMAN (CONT'D)

So that's where it goes. Oh. And it goes there too? Oh. And there?

EXT. HIGHWAY - NIGHT

RANDY drives home. COUNTRY MUSIC on the radio.

A SEMI cuts him off.

RANDY

What in the hell?

He looks at the trailer - a picture of PEYTON MANNING next to a bowl of dog food. Randy flips his shit.

RANDY (CONT'D)

I'll show you for cutting me off, Peyton Manning! ARRRGH!!!

He swerves but misses the semi. His car goes off-road, crashing into a nearby snowdrift. Randy steps out.

RANDY (CONT'D)

ARRRGH!!!

ON THE RADIO: A PROMO

PEYTON MANNING

Join me, Peyton Manning, for the top country hits of the week leading up to the Super Bowl. Only on B-Country 98.

RANDY
ARRRGH!!!

Randy pulls the radio from his car and THROWS it. It spins through the air before hitting a metal pole.

Above the pole: A billboard. On the billboard: PEYTON MANNING promoting prefabricated utility sheds.

RANDY (CONT'D)
ARRRGH!!!

Randy climbs the pole and KICKS the billboard repeatedly.

INT. STAN'S HOUSE - NIGHT

STAN on the couch. A KNOCK at the door. He answers.

OFFICER BARBRADY holds RANDY by the collar.

OFFICER BARBRADY
Is your mother here?

STAN
Dad, what happened?

RANDY
Peyton Manning happened, son.

Sharon rushes in.

SHARON
Randy? Did you get arrested?

OFFICER BARBRADY
Ma'am, your husband was found defacing a billboard on the side of the highway.

SHARON
Defacing a billboard?

OFFICER BARBRADY
Yes. He also made lewd comparisons to America's favorite quarterback and feminine hygiene products.

Randy struggles. Officer Barbrady tases him. Randy goes limp.

SHARON
Well thank you for taking him home, Officer Barbrady. We appreciate it.

OFFICER BARBRADY
 He's actually coming with me to the station. We found glass in his boots that matches the broken televisions downtown.

SHARON
 Randy, you caused that damage?

Randy whimpers.

OFFICER BARBRADY
 I'm afraid so. He has an unhealthy disdain for Peyton Manning. It's so intense it's almost homoerotic.

RANDY
 That douche bag Peyton --

Officer Barbrady tases Randy again.

STAN
 Hey! Quit it!

SHARON
 Well if you're taking him down to the station then why did you stop here?

OFFICER BARBRADY
 I thought maybe I could teach your young son a lesson about private property and respect for the law.

STAN
 Cops are dicks.

OFFICER BARBRADY
 Very well then. Have a good evening.

Officer Barbrady turns around.

SHARON
 Wait! What about my husband?

OFFICER BARBRADY
 He'll be eligible for bail this Sunday.

RANDY
 Please. Get me out before kickoff.

The door shuts. Newfound determination on Stan's face.

STAN
 You're going down, Peyton Manning.

ACT THREE

INT. AIRPLANE - NIGHT BEFORE THE SUPER BOWL

KYLE, STAN and CARTMAN sit on the plane.

BIG GAY AL walks down the aisle. He is a flight attendant.

BIG GAY AL

Boys! How are you doing?

STAN

Big Gay Al? What are you doing here?

BIG GAY AL

I'm super! Thanks for asking. Mr. Slave and I are taking a break so I decided to relive my flight attendant days.

KYLE

You were a flight attendant?

BIG GAY AL

Absolutely. I have thousands of happy airline customers under my belt. How did you get on this airplane?

CARTMAN

I stole my mom's wallet and booked the tickets on Priceline.com.

STAN

When the security people told us we were too young Cartman said he was a little person and started crying. It was great.

Big Gay Al opens the overhead compartment and grabs pillows.

We see PROFESSOR CHAOS inside. Big Gay Al does not.

BIG GAY AL

Are you in town for the big game?

STAN

Sort of. We have to stop an NFL player from appearing on television and ruining my parents' marriage.

BIG GAY AL

Sounds fun. Well if you make it down to Kennedy Boulevard give me a call, boys.

Big Gay Al continues down the aisle. Cartman watches.

CARTMAN

Seriously? Could he be any gayer?

KYLE

I still don't know about this, guys. What if our parents find out about the trip?

CARTMAN

Please stop being a bitch, Kyle. Our alibi is foolproof. I told my mom I was staying at your house. Stan told his mom he was staying at my house. And you told your mom you were staying at Stan's house. I can't believe more kids don't use the same method.

INT. KYLE'S HOUSE - DAY

GERALD and SHEILA at the dinner table.

GERALD

Where is Kyle tonight?

SHEILA

Staying over at his friend Stan's house for the weekend.

Gerald is surprised.

GERALD

Is he the one whose dad destroyed the electronics store downtown?

SHEILA

Is our son a television? All you do is worry. You sound like my mother.

EXT. AIRPORT - DAY

KYLE, STAN and CARTMAN walk through, each carrying a bag. They don't see PROFESSOR CHAOS lurking behind.

PROFESSOR CHAOS

Wait until they see their luggage tags.

Professor Chaos dips behind a corner. Stan notices his tag.

STAN

That's weird, Kyle. Why is your luggage tag on my bag?

KYLE

I don't know. That is weird.

Kyle and Stan exchange tags and continue on their way.
Professor Chaos emerges from his hiding place.

PROFESSOR CHAOS
Rats! Foiled again.

EXT. HOTEL - THAT NIGHT

KYLE, STAN and CARTMAN outside a PREGAME PARTY. They wear black outfits and camouflage face paint.

CARTMAN
I have information that Peyton Manning is inside this party, Stan. The big game is tomorrow, so this is an opportune chance to get a hold of him before he can ruin your parents' marriage.

STAN
What are we supposed to do?

Cartman stalls. Kyle has a revelation.

KYLE
You're not just going to walk up behind him and smother his face with Chloroform, are you? I can't believe this, Cartman. You're such a dipshit --

Cartman pounces. He smothers Kyle. Kyle faints.

STAN
What the hell are you doing, man? You're out of control with the Chloroform.

Cartman smothers Stan. Stan faints.

CARTMAN
Holy shit. This stuff is so cool. And completely odorless...

Cartman curiously sniffs the cloth. He faints.

PEYTON MANNING exits the party. His SPORTS CAR is waiting.

TWO VALET ATTENDANTS see him from a distance.

VALET ATTENDANT #1
Great. Here comes that giant douche bag Peyton Manning.

VALET ATTENDANT #2
What do you have against Peyton Manning?

VALET ATTENDANT #1

Besides the car he drives, his beautiful wife, millions of dollars and countless trophies and records? Nothing.

PEYTON MANNING

Hey, guys. Thanks for grabbing my car.

Peyton Manning slips them both a tip, gets in.

VALET ATTENDANT #2

Dude! Peyton Manning just gave us both fifty-dollar tips!

VALET ATTENDANT #1

He's still a douche bag.

Peyton Manning exits his car.

PEYTON MANNING

Hey fellas. I forgot something.

He runs back and hands them a pair of tickets.

PEYTON MANNING (CONT'D)

I had two extra tickets to the game tomorrow. Enjoy yourselves.

Peyton Manning walks to his car.

VALET ATTENDANT #2

Peyton Manning just gave us Super Bowl tickets! And field passes!

VALET ATTENDANT #1

He's still a total douche bag. Did you see the look on his face?

Peyton Manning returns again and hands them stacks of money.

PEYTON MANNING

One more thing, guys. Please take this money and donate it to a local charity of your choice. I've been so embraced by the residents of Tampa Bay that I want to repay them for their generosity.

Peyton Manning returns to his car and drives off. A silence. The Valet Attendants look at each other.

VALET ATTENDANT #2

Okay. That was kind of douchey.

EXT. HOTEL - THE NEXT MORNING

KYLE, STAN and CARTMAN awake with headaches.

KYLE

Jesus Christ, Cartman. Why did you stick Chloroform in my face?

CARTMAN

I don't know what came over me. But I'm better now. I promise.

Cartman stands and falls on his face. Stan and Kyle do the same. Their shoelaces are tied together.

KYLE

What the hell, Cartman? Did you do this too? You're such a dick.

CARTMAN

I'd never do something this screwed up, man. This is so fucked.

PROFESSOR CHAOS giggles behind a corner.

STAN

We need to get to the stadium. The pregame starts in twenty minutes.

INT. STAN'S HOUSE - CONTINUOUS

RANDY sits on the couch, wearing an ankle bracelet. He drinks a beer. SHARON washes dishes.

RANDY (TO HIMSELF)

After a few days in slammer, I just want to watch some football. Please God keep that douche bag Peyton Manning off my television screen.

EXT. SUPER BOWL PARKING LOT - CONTINUOUS

KYLE, STAN and CARTMAN run from a cab. The driver is another victim of Chloroform. Cartman sees something. He is startled.

CARTMAN

Oh no. The Duggars.

The DUGGAR FAMILY exits a bus. JIM BOB DUGGAR counts the children as they walk down the steps.

JIM BOB DUGGAR

Okay. We have Joshua, Jana, John, Jill,
Jessa, Jinger, Joseph, Josiah, Joy,
Jedidiah, Jeremiah, Jason, James, Justin,
Jackson, Johannah, Jennifer...

MICHELLE DUGGAR exits with a BABY.

JIM BOB DUGGAR (CONT'D)

And there is Jordyn-Grace. I'm so excited
to be taking the whole family to the
Super Bowl, Michelle. Aren't you?

Michelle Duggar seems less than enthused.

MICHELLE DUGGAR

Yes, Jim Bob. It's a nice change of pace
from shoving gremlins out of my crotch.

Cartman is still frozen.

STAN

What the hell, Cartman?

CARTMAN

Look at those evil bastards. How did they
know that I'd be here?

STAN

Let's go, Cartman. Me and Kyle will get
inside the stadium and find Peyton
Manning. You go to the control room.

Cartman snaps out of it.

CARTMAN

I'll do whatever it takes. Just please
keep those Duggars away.

INT. SUPER BOWL STADIUM - CONTINUOUS

AL MICHAELS and JOHN MADDEN perform a soundcheck in a booth.

AL MICHAELS

This is Al Michaels. THIS IS Al Michaels.

JOHN MADDEN

This is John Madden. This IS John Madden.

AL MICHAELS

Can you hear us down there, Peyton? We
have about five minutes until pregame.

PEYTON MANNING on the sidelines.

PEYTON MANNING
I can hear you, fellas. It's a real treat
to be able to work with you.

AL MICHAELS
Peyton, we'll be throwing it down to you
the moment someone hobbles to the
sidelines. Can you handle that, stud?

Peyton Manning awkward.

PEYTON MANNING
Sure. No problem.

JOHN MADDEN
So if anyone pulls a muscle, be ready.

AL MICHAELS
Even if a player sneezes. Peytonville!

INT. SUPER BOWL TUNNEL - CONTINUOUS

A TOUR GUIDE leads THE DUGGAR FAMILY. STAN and KYLE blend in
with the kids. They approach PEYTON MANNING.

TOUR GUIDE
To your left you'll see the NFL's
favorite quarterback, Peyton Manning.
Peyton is acting as a sideline reporter
and is also one of the musical guests
performing at half time.

Peyton Manning practices.

PEYTON MANNING
THIS is Peyton Manning. This IS Peyton
Manning. This is PEYTON MANNING! Dammit.

TOUR GUIDE
It looks like Peyton is getting ready for
the pregame show. Let's leave him alone.

The Duggars leave. Stan and Kyle stay behind.

STAN
There he is. What should I do?

BIG GAY AL approaches.

KYLE
Big Gay Al? What are you doing here?

BIG GAY AL
I'm super! Thanks for asking. I was
invited by my good friend Peyton Manning.

STAN
You know that douche bag?

BIG GAY AL
Peyton Manning isn't a douche bag at all.
We worked a USO tour together during the
late '90s. He's super!

STAN
But if I don't stop Peyton Manning from
being on television my parents might get
a divorce. Or kill each other.

BIG GAY AL
Just talk to him, Stan. Peyton Manning is
a great listener.

INT. STAN'S HOUSE - CONTINUOUS

RANDY opens a new beer.

RANDY
Eight minutes of television without that
douche bag Peyton Manning. That must be
some kind of record.

EXT. CONTROL ROOM - CONTINUOUS

A GUARD in front of the door. CARTMAN walks by casually.

CARTMAN
Excuse me, sir. I won a contest and get
to sit inside the control room during the
Super Bowl. Here is the certificate.

The Guard bends down to Cartman's level. Cartman smothers his
face. The Guard faints.

INT. SUPER BOWL STADIUM - CONTINUOUS

PEYTON MANNING still rehearsing.

PEYTON MANNING
I'm Peyton Manning. THIS is the NFL. This
IS the NFL. What am I even doing here?

STAN approaches. BIG GAY AL and KYLE watch.

STAN

Mr. Manning?

PEYTON MANNING

Hey, little buddy. I'd talk to you but we're about to start the pregame show.

STAN

Please don't go on the air, Mr. Manning.

PEYTON MANNING

But I have people counting on me. What's your name, little guy?

STAN

Stan. If my dad sees you on television he and my mom are going to get a divorce.

PEYTON MANNING

I'm afraid your parents' problems don't have much to do with me, Stan.

STAN

That's not true. Every time my dad sees your face on TV my mom and him get into a fight. It's because you're a douche bag.

INT. CONTROL ROOM - CONTINUOUS

CARTMAN sneaks in. SEVERAL STAFF work in front of a WALL OF TELEVISION SCREENS. THE DIRECTOR shouts orders.

DIRECTOR

Okay, we're about to go live. Ready the Peyton Cam and the Peyton commercials.

STAFF #1

Wait! Something is happening with Peyton and a kid on the sideline.

DIRECTOR

Cut the intro! Cut the music! Go straight to Peyton Manning on the field!

CARTMAN

No!

Cartman goes nuts. IN A FLASH he Chloroforms the entire room. The Director goes limp. His head hits a BUTTON. EVERY SCREEN is now switched to the same SHOT OF PEYTON MANNING.

CARTMAN (CONT'D)

Oops.

INT. SUPER BOWL STADIUM - CONTINUOUS

PEYTON MANNING'S FACE on the JUMBOTRON. His voice ECHOES through the stadium and AROUND THE WORLD.

PEYTON MANNING

Stan, that is a very hurtful word. How did you learn about 'douche bag?'

STAN

My dad taught it to me.

INT. STAN'S HOUSE - CONTINUOUS

RANDY'S jaw drops. A SHOT OF PEYTON MANNING AND STAN is stuck on his screen too. SHARON rushes in and SCREAMS

RANDY

Peyton Manning stole my son!

SHARON

It's your fault. I had to raise him while you were sitting in jail!

RANDY

Oh, like you've never spent the weekend in the county lockup?

INT. SUPER BOWL STADIUM - CONTINUOUS

PEYTON MANNING kneels next to STAN.

PEYTON MANNING

You know, Stan, people yelled the word 'douche bag' at my dad when he played for the New Orleans Saints. And I heard it all through school when kids picked on my younger brother Eli, who suffers from Down Syndrome.

STAN

Eli Manning has Down Syndrome?

Peyton Manning doesn't miss a beat.

PEYTON MANNING

I've even used 'douche bag' before too, when referring to NFL commentators like Chris Collinsworth and Tiki Barber.

INT. STAN'S HOUSE - CONTINUOUS

RANDY and SHARON are in a face-off, with PISTOLS pointed at each other's heads. Sweat drips from Randy's brow.

RANDY
Go ahead! Pull the trigger!

EXT. SUPER BOWL STADIUM - CONTINUOUS

PEYTON MANNING is still preaching to STAN.

PEYTON MANNING
I've thought a lot about that word and the pain it causes, Stan. And do you know what I think?

STAN
No, Peyton Manning. I don't.

PEYTON MANNING
I think sometimes people get angry and instead of talking about their feelings they'd rather tear down a celebrity through the use of an ugly moniker. But that celebrity is just living his life. He doesn't want to hurt anyone or rub their noses in his own success. He doesn't even know what a douche bag is or what it looks like. And do you know what else I think?

STAN
No, Peyton Manning, I don't.

PEYTON MANNING
I think when a person calls someone else a douche bag, we have to ask ourselves - isn't that person really just being a douche bag himself?

STAN
Wow. I never really thought about it that way, Peyton Manning.

INT. CONTROL ROOM - CONTINUOUS

CARTMAN watches in amazement. A TEAR streams down his face.

CARTMAN
He's right. Peyton Manning is so right.

The DIRECTOR raises his head. Cartman Chloroforms him again.

INT. STAN'S HOUSE - CONTINUOUS

RANDY and SHARON have stopped. They watch the TV.

SHARON
What is Stan doing there?

RANDY
I think he's trying to save our marriage.

They embrace.

EXT. SUPER BOWL STADIUM - CONTINUOUS

PEYTON MANNING and STAN hug each other. The crowd ERUPTS. The TWO VALET ATTENDANTS sit in the stands.

VALET ATTENDANT #1
Now that was a douche bag move.

VALET ATTENDANT #2
Definitely.

EXT. CONTROL ROOM - CONTINUOUS

THE DUGGARS follow the TOUR GUIDE.

TOUR GUIDE
And this is the control room.

The door swings open. CARTMAN exits. The Duggars see several limp bodies inside. Cartman sees the Duggars.

CARTMAN
AHHHH!!!

DUGGARS
AHHHH!!!

PROFESSOR CHAOS sneaks around a corner.

PROFESSOR CHAOS
Where did those three go? You can run but
you can't hide from Professor Chaos!

The Duggars become a frantic herd and engulf Professor Chaos. He is swept onto the bus against his will.

PROFESSOR CHAOS (CONT'D)
No! Please help! Who are you people?

The bus drives away. Professor Chaos SCREAMS down the street.
